DEFAULT IMAGE: Firearm at side — low-ready, muzzle down. Weapon visible but not raised. Dog tags on beaded chain (printed on target). This is the only TIM model that defaults to an ELEVATED / AMBIGUOUS classification — the weapon is present but not an immediate active threat. The badge chain overlay drops over the subject's head with no magnet required, converting the scenario to a plainclothes officer NO SHOOT — CRITICAL in under 2 seconds. Free hand and waistband overlays use one RapidSwap magnet each and can be used simultaneously. **Custom agency badge available as an upcharge — contact us for pricing.**

CHEST / NECK CHAIN Dog tags (default — printed) Police badge on chain (drops over head — no magnet) Custom agency badge available

FREE HAND Empty — at side (default) Umbrella overlay Fixed blade knife overlay (one RapidSwap magnet)

WAISTBAND None (default) Concealed handgun overlay (one RapidSwap magnet) All three positions usable simultaneously

INSTRUCTOR NOTE: Low-Ready Officer is the only TIM model that defaults to ELEVATED / AMBIGUOUS — the weapon is present and visible but not an immediate threat. This trains threat level assessment, not just threat identification. The badge chain conversion is the fastest scenario change in the TIM system — under 2 seconds, no magnet required. Run the badge scenarios frequently. Friendly-fire incidents involving plainclothes officers are among the most preventable tragedies in law enforcement.
